



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR OFFICIALS (Managers, Coaches and Officials)

As a Regional Representative / Manager / Coach / Arbiter to the South African Junior Chess Championships of 2019, I agree to:

1. Represent myself and my Region to the best of my ability;
2. Conduct myself in a manner which will bring credit to myself, the role I am fulfilling and my Region;
3. Abide, at all times, by the rules and regulations of the Organisers, FIDE and Chess SA, including but not limited to the FIDE laws of chess, the rules of the tournament and any team rules as laid down by the Organisers;
4. Accept and abide at all times by the decisions of the Arbiters and Organisers;
5. Act at all times in the best interests of chess and as expected from a member of CHESS SA;
6. Be bound by the decisions of the tournament Disciplinary Committee, such Committee to consist of at least the Chief Arbiter of the tournament, one arbiter not officiating at the tournament, one person from the LOC and one person from Chess SA.
7. Any disciplinary proceedings detail be made available to the Disciplinary Committee of CHESS SA, which may result in further action from them.
8. Bring any problems that may occur during the tournament to the immediate attention of the Chief Arbiter or LOC who will address it accordingly and where required in strict confidence.

I _____ being appointed/selected by my Region and/or the LOC, under the auspices of CHESS SA to represent my Region at the South African Junior Chess Championships of 2019, hereby accept the above Code of Conduct and agree to adhere to it at all times.

Furthermore, I accept that any contravention of the above may result in me being suspended from further participation in the tournaments and disciplinary action taken against me.
